VOLUME CONTROL

- When desired setting is selected, don't press anything for 1 second and it will return back to the fairy greeting screen.

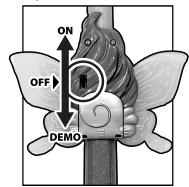
Fern is so sweet with her pink dress and hair. She's smart and courageous, with wisdom to share!

- The Fairy Wand ships in "Try Me" mode - she will only play 3 or 4 animations when you press the button.
- You will want to move the switch from "Try Me" to "ON" to experience all of Fern's spells, comments, adventures, and animation.

- When you're done playing, you can either turn the wand off by moving the switch to the "OFF" position, or just set the wand down for 3 minutes. After 3 minutes of no activity or interaction, Fern will go to sleep.
- To "wake" Fairy Princess Fern, press the button, or side switch "off" and back "on" again!



TO RESET

· If the Fairy Wand freezes or locks up, simply turn it off and back on again

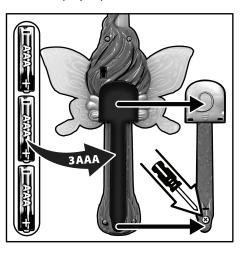

CHANGING & INSTALLING BATTERIES

- 1. Open the battery hatch using a small Phillips head screwdriver
- 2. Slide battery hatch off of handle
- 3. Replace with 3 fresh AAA batteries
- 4. Replace battery hatch
- 5. Properly dispose of old batteries



BATTERY INFORMATION

- Always replace used batteries with fresh Alkaline batteries.
 Only batteries of the same type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Do not mix old batteries with new, do not mix Alkaline with standard zinc or rechargeable nickel cadmium batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- •The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

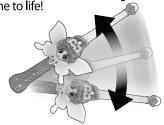
